Most of the departments have done commendable work both academically and in other extension activities. By evaluating the documents submitted by the Arts, Humanities & Commerce departments I would like to propose some recommendations for improvement as follows:

1. Publications to be improved with importance to be given for UGC Care list or Scopus indexed. (Especially by Research scholars, can be made mandatory)
2. Online courses can be encouraged for all students maybe two anytime during their term of study.

3. MoU must be signed with more of Academic bodies rather than for extension activities. MoU with the same organisation cannot be claimed by two departments as MoU for each. (noted during presentation – Nandhi organization)
4. Students to be encouraged to take up National level tests – NET, SET, GATE/ CA, UPSC, Civil Services etc.,
5. Skill-based courses, to be made compulsory for each Programme and this can be even online courses. Job oriented courses to be related to the Programme offering the courses.
6. Extension activities are highly commendable and can be a model for other HE institutions.
7. Students to try for internships with good organisations, some even with stipends. Alumni in good positions can help.
8. Seminars – National and International can be organized with paper presentations which will help in publications for the College journals also.
9. Club activities of all departments are commendable, including gender sensitisation, day observations etc. are also noteworthy.
10. Department level library registers to be maintained to evidence the use of books and especially reference book issue from book banks can be encouraged.
11. Sports department is commended for excellent work. Try to encourage individual sports for more recognition. (Departments need not present Sports achievements of their students as it is claimed by Sports department)
