SCOPE

- ii. This agreement shall not be binding for any other agreement for either party. Parties shall be free and independent to carry on other services and training besides that covered under the scope of this agreement.
- iii. The ASSOCIATE shall strictly follow the INSTITUTION norms, rules and regulations for conducting the programs and shall maintain the INSTITUTION high standards.
- iv. All courseware provided by the ASSOCIATE is its copy right. Confidentiality of same shall be maintained and the INSTITUTION should ensure it is not replicated in the other Centre or outside.
