### REPORT

NSS unit of mercy college conducted on orientation class on the topic “**Diversity personality**” by **Shobindran** sir. The program was coordinated by an organization called “pachap” on 10th of January. 88 NSS volunteers attended the class. He also planted a sapling (gooseberry) at Mercy ground.



The students from big bazar higher secondary school and pallipuram up school were brought to Mercy College to show zoology **museum** and **botanical garden** of Mercy College on 11th january. It was coordinated by 75 NSS volunteers. Refreshment was given to all the students and their travelling expenses were also taken by NSS.



The NSS volunteers reached Mercy College for cleaning the campus on 12th of January. Nearly 30 volunteers participated in the cleaning activity. Lime Juice were also distributed to the non-teaching staffs of Mercy College.



National eco fest 2018 was conducted on 23/01/2019 and 24/01/2019 at **AADI** center Attapadi which was coordinated by **Fr. Lennin Antony**. 55 NSS volunteers attended this Eco Fest. Several competitions like group song, drama, versification, essay writing ...were conducted there. Our volunteers participated in it.



As a part of Prime Minister Narendra Modi's clarion call for youth-led-development a screening was held at Victoria college on 19/Jan/2019. 10 NSS volunteers participated in it. 3 among them were selected to **District level youth parliament competition**. Selected volunteers participated in district level competition held on 23rd of January at Victoria college.



In connection with **Republic day** (26/01/2019) NSS volunteers cleaned Public Park near BEM school. Later, distributed chocolates and cards containing good quotes among auto drivers and other peoples. Conducted a rally to **Fort Maidan** for making awareness to people about pollution. 42 volunteers participated in these activities.



An organization called ASHRAYA conducted a trekking program on 27th of January. Nearly 30 NSS volunteers participated in the program. Trekking was done from seetharkund and reached near nelliampathy. Students also engaged in Natural meditation from the top of mountain.



Several ornamental plants were planted at GHSS Bigbazar. Plants were brought from Mercy College. 20 volunteers participated in it. Also cleaned GHSS Bigbazar.



A mega fest “IGNITE” was conducted at govt college chittur by the department of commerce and NSS unit on 19/feb/2019. 43 NSS volunteers visited the fest . participated in management games and other programs.



Health department organized an antifilaria rally on 21/Feb/2019. The rally extended from Municipality to stadium. 81 NSS volunteers participated in this awareness program. A awareness drama were also arranged by the health department.



Harvesting of the paddy field of Mercy college near kannikamatha school was held on 6th of march. 70 NSS volunteers visited to learn about harvesting. Information regarding paddy cultivation was shared by sr. Lisieux rose, incharge of Mercy mess .Also engaged in cleaning the harvested area.



Jyothikrishna Rehabilitation center for blinds were visited by the NSS volunteers on 9th of march. Distributed cakes and biscuits there. Several cultural activities were done by the volunteers. Also served and had lunch with them. 30 volunteers engaged in these activities.



Palakkad district anti-tuberculosis team organized a rally on tuberculosis day (24/3/2019). From district hospital Palakkad to chembai musical institution followed the inauguration



ceremony. 35 NSS volunteers participated.



**Satmyam II**, intercollege one day Leadership camp was conducted at **MES KALLADI** college by NSS district unit Palakkad and the main session was dealed by **Shafi Pulpara** , NSS program officer MES college **chathamangalam**. 40 NSS volunteers participated in the camp and certificates were also distributed to the participated volunteers.



Data collection and survey for biodiversity register was conducted by **KERALA BIODIVERSITY BOARD** on the month of may. 50 NSS volunteers participated in the data Collection and survey. 4 days were worked for collecting survey and 3 days were spend for review.

Inconnection with **World Environment day** (05/06./2019). Nss volunteers planted trees in palakkad Fort. And cleaned the surroundings in the campus. About 5 NSS volunteers participated in the program. The program was organized by Municipality of Palakkad.



**World blood donation day** was organized by district medical ,health office, Palakkad and NSS .District collector **Sri.D.Balamurali** inaugurated the program in the presence of Sr.Gizalla, vice principal mercycollege. They also announced the result of online poster making competition and published all the posters made by the participants.



**5th international yoga day celebration** (district level) was conducted by **Nehru YUVA Kendra sangathan** on 21st of june. The program was inaugurated by **municipal chairperson** and many yoga champions. It was held in prasanalakshmi auditorium.50 NSS volunteers participated in **yoga day celebration.**



On 22nd of June **NSS volunteers** planted 16 saplings received from the department of botany in Mercy ground. 11 bushes and 20 other ornamental plants were planted. Later 4 saplings were planted in the Mercy home and also visited the mothers of Mercy home. 40 NSS volunteers were active.



38 NSS volunteers initiated a vegetable garden in Mercy College on 29th June, also volunteered “**Minikrishi home**” a program for mothers. Organized by MalayalaManorama with the help of VFPCCK. Held on the same day at Mercy College. Helped them with registration, packing and distribution of vegetable saplings.





18 volunteers participated in gardening the vegetables given by the organizers of “minikrishi home “ on 13th of July. Guidelines for planting vegetables were given by the Gardner of Mercy college. Several vegetables like Tomato, Brinjal, Tapioca...were included in the garden.



As a follow-up for the ornamental plants planted in the college ground, we visited them and replaced some among them on 20/7/19. Later a pledge was taken on swach bharat at Mercy Ground 26 NSS volunteers participated.



An awareness class for sustainable access to safe water program was held at mercy college organized by water, PSSP and **jal sakthi abhiyan**. The awareness was given by **K.D.JOSEPH** project coordinator **SAS** water in Palakkad. Program was introduced by **Fr.Shaji.M.J**, chief executive and executive secretary PSSP. Thus Jal Sakthi Campus Day was celebrated and initiated the formation of blue army.



Distributed “**pothichor**” among the poor beggars seen in the street from mercy college to BEM school. 21 NSS volunteers participated. Each volunteers brought packets from their home. Also Visited nearby masjid to distribute the remaining packets. Totally 25 packets were distributed on that day.



**Flood relief collection point** was started in mercy college on 10/aug/2019. NSS Volunteers were divided to mercy college, Victoria college and Gayathri

auditorium. Things collected at mercy college were distributed to the collection point of Victoria college. 15 volunteers were totally involved.



On 11th of August, Collection point at mercy college was opened from 7am in the morning. 15 volunteer participated. Some among them went to nearby houses and shops to collect products. Collected products were distributed to pirayiri auditorium. And 8 volunteers went to Victoria college as volunteers to distribute the remaining products from mercy college to Victoria college.



National service scheme Palakkad district wise flood relief collection for wayanad started on 12th of august . Mercy college was the main collection point. The collection point was active from 7:00 in the morning to 6:00 in the evening. Notice related to flood relief was printed and distributed at civil station, KSRTC, town stand , municipal stand, stadium bus stand later the collected products were sorted.
