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REPORT

DAY-1 22.12.2023

National Service Scheme seven day residential camp 'PRAVAHA 2023' of Mercy College officially started by assembling at the college at 3.30 PM and marched to the assigned residence (GLPS Kallikad School, Palakkad). The proclamation march started at 4 PM from college to GLPS Kallikad.



The inauguration ceremony was started by the welcome address of Ms. Riddhi.R, a volunteer of NSS in the presence of the Ward (47) Councillor Ms. Mini Babu, Ward Member of the residential area Mr. Hassan Uppa, Ward Member of Thirunellayi Mr.A.Krishnan, HM of Kallikad School Ms. Bindu, Principal of Mercy College Dr. Sr. Jorry T. F along with the NSS staff coordinators Ms. Vini, Dr. Deepa N., Dr. Anu Kuruvila, Ms. Thushara N.C, Mr. Jayanth Kumar and the NSS Volunteers. Principal of Mercy College Dr. Sr. Jorry T. F inaugurated the Camp. In the inaugural session, felicitation were offered by Ms. Mini Babu, Mr. Hassan Uppa and Mr.A Krishnan. The Programme Officers who were present on the dais delivered their felicitation for the camp to be enjoyable and successful. A small interactive session between the Guest and the volunteers followed the

official ceremony. The ceremony concluded around 5:30 PM with the vote of thanks delivered by NSS volunteer Ms.Nihala.





Kalavaranirakkal – collection of the vegetables and articles for cooking brought by the volunteers was done. Volunteers brought coconut, vegetables, pickle, pappad etc to the camp which was collected for the use in the coming days.



After the ceremony the volunteers were divided into seven groups and were assigned certain duties to arrange rooms for the medical camp which was planned to conduct on 23/12/2023 at Mercy College, Palakkad. All the arrangements were done around 8:30 PM. A meeting was held at 9 PM to discuss about the responsibilities of each team for the next day and the schedule was distributed. Since it was the first day and the room for residing were arranged. A short cultural programme was arranged. Thereafter we concluded the day with dinner.



Cardiopulmonary resuscitation can help save a life during cardiac arrest,

when the heart stops beating or beats too ineffectively to circulate blood to the brain and other vital organs. As a first-line response that can help save someone's life in an emergency, this technique aims to keep oxygen moving to vital organs, especially the brain, until the heart can beat on its own again. Volunteers were shown the procedure of CPR . The session was very informative.



The volunteers were surprised by the unexpected visit of Principal Dr.Sr Jorry T.F. along with Vice Principal Dr.Sr. Merin and Bursar Sr Laya. To the surprise of volunteers dear Sisters also brought Christmas cake. Principal gave the Christmas message and volunteers enjoyed singing Christmas songs and carol.





Demonstration of the voting procedures was explained to every volunteer by Mr. Aneesh K.V., Mr. Bhavadas M and Ms. Sameeha P.S. Volunteers were shown the procedure of voting in Electronic Voting Machine. Mr Toms explained the two units: the control unit and the balloting unit designed in EVM. Sir explained that the control unit of the EVM is kept with the presiding officer or the polling officer. The balloting unit is kept within the voting compartment for electors to cast their votes.

The session helped the volunteers to develop a culture of electoral participation and maximize the informed and ethical voting and follow the principle 'Every vote counts' and 'No Voter to be Left Behind'.



After the tea break, volunteers had an interactive session with the Head Mistress of Govt. L.P. School Kallikkad Ms. Bindhu. Madam elaborated on the importance of NSS Activities and the role of NSS volunteers in the community.
