REPORT 2022-23

Social Service League (SSL) Mercy College is the NGO of Mercy College, Palakkad has been stood as the backbone for the vivid performance in social service for the college as well as for the people outside of the college.

Family Counselling Centre of Mercy College was established in the year of 1991 with the help of Central Social Welfare Board, New Delhi. It functions under Social Service League, Mercy College. During 2022-23, around “**164**” new cases are handled and also follow-ups are done. The Counselors deal with different types of cases such as, marital problems, Family issues, Individual problems etc. During this period we conducted “**26**” awareness programs, and also the Counsellors attended “**7**” different type of Programmes during this period and Counsellors participated “**5**” times in women commission adhalath done by state women commission. We conducted “**2**” subcommittee meetings.

Service Providing Centre also functions under Social Service League, Mercy College. During these periods around “**65**” new cases are handled and 63% follow ups were done. 35 cases settled through counselling, court, and DLSA.

We run Rajiv Gandhi National Creche as the part of SSL with 25 kids to support the working women in the locality. The function of crèche is been periodically checked by the child protection officer.

Kaval Plus project which also run under the NGO Social Service League, Mercy College Palakkad that started in the year 2021 in order to provide protection and care sexually abused children. The project considers the cases obtained through district child protection office and child welfare committee. It aims the social upliftment of these children and around 50 children and their families got service through this project in this year.

Report on 'Thannal' for the aged at the Mercy Home

The Social Service League of Mercy College successfully donated 25 beds to Mercy Home through its new initiative, Thannal on 21st December 2022. The initiative aimed to collect funds to donate beds to Mercy Home, a non-profit organization that provides shelter and care for the elderly and disabled. The SSL was able to raise approximately 60,000/- through this initiative and was introduced by the SSL to provide comfortable sleeping arrangements for the residents of Mercy Home. The organization identified the need for beds at the Mercy Home facility and decided to raise funds to donate them. The Thannal initiative was launched on 15th December 2022 and was open to the public to donate towards the cause. The initiative was well received by the public, and donations poured in from various sources from students, faculties, and others. The SSL also promoted the initiative through its social media platforms, which helped in spreading the word and encouraging more donations. Through the generous contributions of individuals and organizations, the Thannal initiative was able to raise approximately 60,000/- in a span of 6 days. The donation was made to buy beds and donated in the presence of residents and staff of Mercy Home, as well as representatives of the SSL.
