Communicative English Workshop Report

Venue: Holy Family College of Education for Women, Koduvayur

Department: B.Ed Programme

Duration: 3 Hours

Participants: First Year B.Ed Students

Resource Persons: 12 Students (Communicative English Team)

Objectives of the Workshop

1. To enhance communicative competence among first-year B.Ed students.
2. To develop confidence in spoken English through interactive activities.
3. To improve listening, speaking, and interpersonal skills.
4. To encourage participatory and activity-based language learning.
5. To demonstrate the effectiveness of games and role-play as pedagogical tools.
6. To prepare future teachers to adopt communicative approaches in their classrooms.

Report of the Session

A three-hour Communicative English Workshop was conducted at Marian College, Koduvayur, for 43 first-year B.Ed students. The session was facilitated by a team of 12 student resource persons who designed and executed a series of engaging and learner-centered activities.

The workshop began with an ice-breaking activity aimed at creating a relaxed and interactive atmosphere. This was followed by language games that focused on vocabulary building, fluency, and spontaneous speaking. Activities such as word association, situational conversations, and group-based speaking challenges encouraged active participation.

The highlight of the session was a series of role-playing exercises. Students were divided into small groups and assigned real-life classroom and social scenarios. These included teacher-student interactions, parent-teacher meetings, classroom management situations, and everyday communication contexts. The role-play sessions allowed participants to practice tone, body language, clarity, and confidence in speech.


The resource persons ensured that the activities were collaborative and inclusive. Constructive feedback was provided after each activity to help students reflect on their strengths and areas for

improvement. The session concluded with a brief reflection segment where participants shared their experiences and learning outcomes.

The workshop was interactive, dynamic, and well-received by the participants.

Outcomes of the Workshop

1. Participants demonstrated improved confidence in speaking English.
2. Students became more aware of effective communication strategies in classroom contexts.
3. The workshop reduced hesitation and fear associated with public speaking.
4. Participants understood the importance of communicative and activity-based teaching methods.
5. The session fostered teamwork, collaboration, and peer learning.
6. Future teachers gained practical ideas for integrating games and role-play into their own teaching practice.
