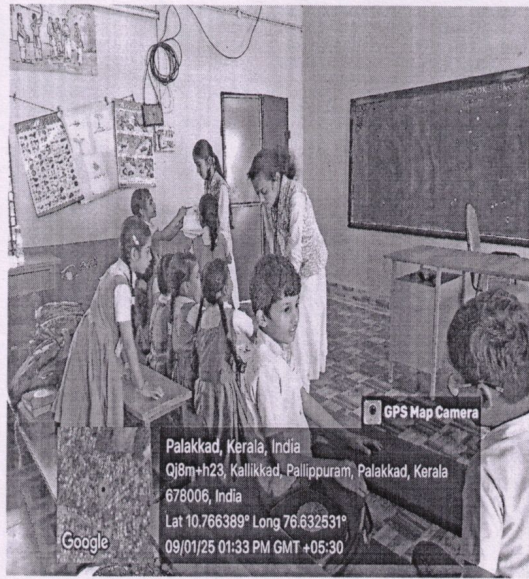


### **AKSHARA Report**

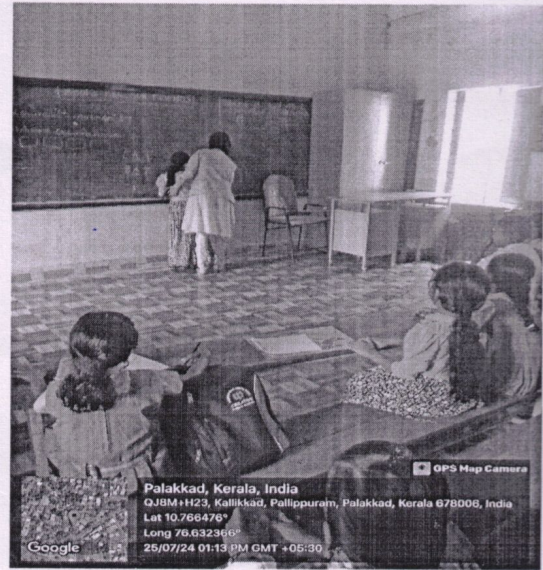

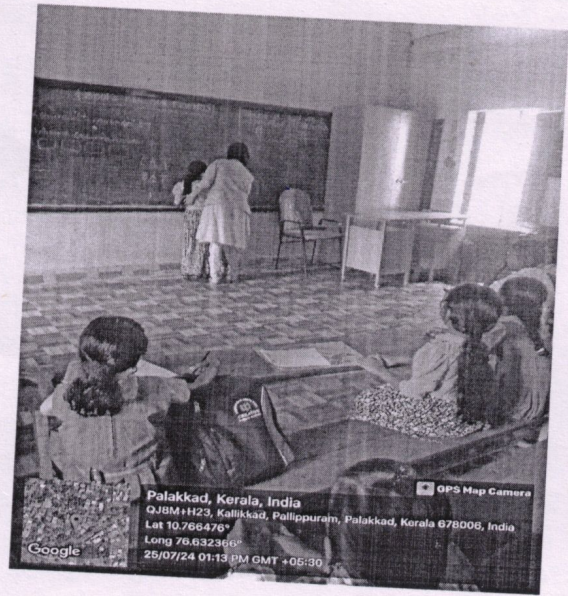
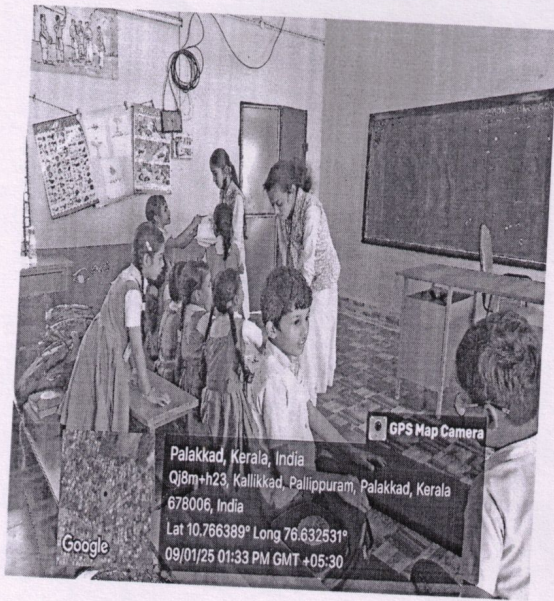
