

The faculty and students of the Department of Languages, Mercy College, Palakkad, participated in a one-day literary seminar commemorating the 325th anniversary of the arrival of Arnos Padiri in Kerala on 16 February 2026 at St. Thomas College, Thrissur. The participation was organized as part of the academic initiatives of the Arnos Padiri Chair at Mercy College, which is dedicated to studying and promoting the linguistic, literary, and cultural contributions of the scholar-priest. The seminar was a collaborative initiative organized by the Velur Arnos Padiri Academy, the Kerala Sahitya Akademi, and St. Thomas College. The programme aimed to engage scholars, faculty members, and students in critical discussions on the historical and literary contributions of Arnos Padiri, while also situating his works within contemporary literary and cultural studies. As part of the academic engagement, the participants attended various thematic sessions that explored the enduring legacy of Arnos Padiri. The sessions also included discussions on the Bhakti movement, the role of literature in shaping social consciousness, and the relevance of historical literary figures in contemporary academic discourse. These sessions provided valuable exposure to current approaches in literary criticism and research. The participation in the seminar provided an enriching academic experience for both faculty members and students, enabling meaningful interaction with scholars and academicians. It also offered new perspectives on the literary and historical significance of Arnos Padiri and contributed to strengthening research interests in Malayalam literature.
