- 5. To create specially designed restroom.
- 6. To make available wheel chair.
- 7. To arrange scribes for all differently-abled student to write examination.
- 8. To ensure participation in culture events hosted by college.
- 9. To create friendly barrier-free environment.
- 10. To make reservations as per Government norms.
- 11. To reserve parking area for such students.
- 12. To provide railing on all staircases.
